Our Archdiocese has completed a three year synodal process of consultation, and is on the cusp of beginning to implement the priorities that Archbishop Hebda has discerned based upon what he heard. While the specific priorities will not be announced until the Feast of Christ the King (November 20), the method for implementing them, based in synodality, has been set. At this gathering Archbishop Bernard Hebda, Bishop Joseph Williams, Deacon Joe Michalak and Douglas Bushman will share their insights and discuss the theological grounding for the approach in which we will be engaged together.
