In addition to registration, please note the following:

- Keep a copy of every form you send in and bring it with you to AYD19 in case of emergency.
- Refunds can only be granted up to November 1.
- Additional registrations may be added up to November 1 by mailing in a check, or paying via credit card.

Check In

- All participants should be dropped off at the doors to Saint Thomas Academy.
- There will be a staging area for the youth and chaperones to wait as the group leader checks in.
- Only the group leader should check in. If you have a large group, one additional chaperone may go with the group leader to check in.
- Bring your completed group roster to check-in with the names of only those who are present at AYD19, not everyone who is registered.
