

Office of Synod Evangelization:


Director and staff coordinate the implementation of Archbishop Hebda's Synod Priorities in collaboration with:

Winter-Summer 2023

January:

In person kick-off event of the Parish Synod Evangelization Teams.





February-April:

Parish Synod Evangelization Teams attend 7-session School of Discipleship training with subsequent 40 day challenge.

April/May:

Pastor and Parish Synod Evangelization Teams Planning Day. Pastor and SET team meet one day on a weekend to plan the parish's Expression of the 2023-24 Synod Priorities.



May-August:

SET members recruit potential Small Group Leaders.

Implementation Begins in Parishes
Fall 2023

I. Formation of Small Group Leaders

Training:

All parishes offer 7 session training sessions (via video) for Small Group Leaders.



Attendees:

All those identified as potential Small Groups Leaders as well as any interested parishioners.



Priorities

Parish implements its customized Expression of the Synod Priorities.





Parish Synod Evangelization Teams:

Pastor, in collaboration with his pastoral council and staff, chooses twelve to form his Synod Evangelization Team (SET) members:

- **Ex officio members**: Parochial Vicar, Deacon, School Principal, DRE, Discipleship and Evangelization Director or Youth Director, and Parish Council delegate.
- Parishioners and staff: Chosen at large, distinguished by their (i) proven charism of evangelization and/or (ii) potential to draw others to Christ.
