TABLE DISCUSSION QUESTONS

For the discussion, each person is invited to share on one or two of the following questions:

- What stood out to you in our time of prayer or in the teaching?
- Thinking back on your middle school and high school years, did you have an experience that helped you know and love Jesus (or comment on your child's experience). Please share a little about the experience.
- What can our parishes and schools, in partnership with parents, do to help our youth (grades 6-12) know and love Jesus?

IDEAS FOR CONSIDERATION

These ideas are provided to help you get started in your discussion and to provide a framework to give feedback.

Note: Ideas A – F are the same as topic 5B, adjusted for this age group. Ideas G – K are new ideas.

- A) Formation of Leaders, Catechists and Teachers: Identify, invite, form and equip leaders to provide an authentic, credible, and effective witness of the faith.
- B) Pastor Encouragement and Involvement: Provide witness of visible and active involvement by pastors and clergy in parish faith formation and Catholic schools.
- C) Comprehensive Faith Formation: Partner with parents to teach the Catholic faith in its entirety (creed, sacraments, moral life, prayer and service).
- D) Confirmation: Collaborate with parents to provide a meaningful and fruitful experience as their youth prepare for and receive confirmation.
- E) **Prayer:** Give youth a variety of prayer experiences, helping them find their own personal relationship with Jesus through prayer.
- F) Faith-building Events and Experiences: Provide families with opportunities to encounter and foster a relationship with Jesus (retreats, Extreme Faith Camp, NET, world and local youth days, mission trips, vocational discernment opportunities).
- G) Leadership Roles in the Parish: Help youth personalize the faith for themselves and begin to take leadership roles in their parish, school, and community.
- H) **Evangelization and Service Initiatives**: Provide opportunities and encourage youth to take initiative on evangelization, service, and advocacy initiatives.
- I) Navigating Cultural Challenges: Provide tools for youth to make wise decisions rooted in the teachings of the Church (social media, human sexuality, sanctity of life, faith and science).
- J) Adult Witnesses: Facilitate a connection with adults who support, mentor and are witnesses of the faith.
- K) Small Groups / Discipleship: Offer the opportunity for youth to gather in small groups, with peers and adult mentors, to walk together as they grow in discipleship.
