### **IDEAS FOR CONSIDERATION**

These ideas are provided to help you get started in your discussion and to provide a framework to give feedback.

- A) Regional Leadership Within the Archdiocese: Provide regional leadership for young adult ministry to support young adult-driven initiatives.
- B) Small Groups / Discipleship: Facilitate a small group ministry for young adults.
- C) Mentorship: Provide opportunities to network and connect with experienced adults who can mentor young adults in their faith journeys.
- D) Strong Catechetical Teaching about Current Events: Preach on the truths of the faith even when unpopular.
- E) Community: Provide opportunities and avenues to gather with peers who can help each other live out the faith.
- F) Sharing the Faith with Friends: Offer guidance and tools for sharing the faith with friends in a loving and nonpushy way.
- G) Parish Life: Welcome young adults and integrate them into the life of the parish.
- H) Service Opportunities: Connect young adults with opportunities to serve, especially with peers.
- Communications: Invest in new methods of communication connecting young adults with each other and the life of faith in ways that facilitate the development of meaningful relationships.
- J) College Ministry: Connect high school graduates and college students with Catholic organizations on campus to support them in their faith lives (Newman Centers, SPO, FOCUS), and invest resources to allow these organizations to thrive.
- K) Discernment of Vocation: Provide resources and connect young adults with others who can help them discern their vocation (marriage, priesthood, religious life).
